Thank you for your interest in showing your art at Cupcake Royale! Showcasing the latest work by local artists is another way we embrace the true spirit of coffeehouse culture. It allows us to support local art and to inspire further creativity and conversation. We have 5 cafes with five very different feels, and we make a conscious effort to hang work that is provocative and inspiring, as well as the right fit for the atmosphere.

That said, we expect all artists to hang their shows professionally, and presentation is a crucial element in our consideration of your submission. No nails, tacks, hooks, or adhesives of any kind may be used to hang your show. Your work must either be framed, or the medium must be able to support a hook from which to hang by wire from a picture rail.

Cupcake Royale does not take a commission on the sale of your artwork. The artist is responsible for including the appropriate contact info with the show for those interested in purchasing work.

All artists must sign an Artist's Agreement prior to hanging a show at Cupcake Royale. You will receive the agreement after you have submitted your work.

Artists hanging in Ballard, West Seattle, or Capitol Hill must be present for Art Walk receptions.
